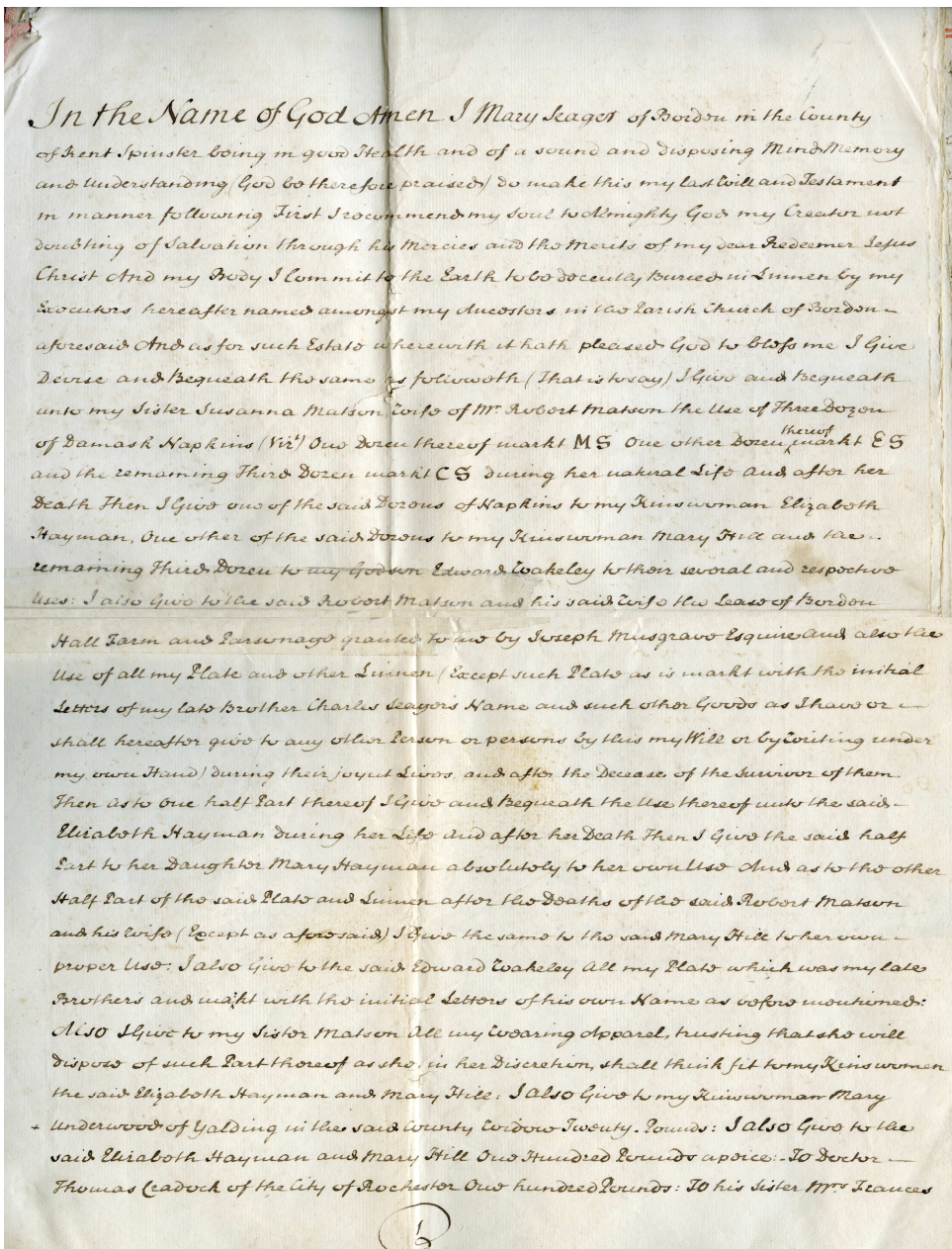


Mary Seager, spinster of this Parish

An interesting 'find' has come to light via our chairman, John Hepburn. A local dealer keeps John in mind when any items relating to Borden come into his possession. The latest of which is the will of the late Mary Seager of Borden.

The Will is dated 1770, and in it Mary lists out all of her possessions to be distributed to relations and associates as well as land. She even mentions such items as napkins and plates and she is very particular as to their distribution!

Mary was the daughter of Charles Seager and his wife Clementia. Mary was baptised on the 24th September 1703, and
